

## 2018 High Holiday Parking at Or Hadash

Below are parking instructions for this year's holidays.

Parking Volunteers will be available to assist you, but please abide by the following important guidelines:

**Erev Rosh Hashanah evening service (Sunday, September 9):** In addition to the parking lot at Or Hadash, we are also permitted to use the parking lots at both Wordsworth Academy and Play N Learn for overflow parking. The wooded path from Wordsworth to Or Hadash will be lit at sundown to facilitate using the path after services to return to your vehicle.

**Rosh Hashanah – first day (Monday, September 10):**

- **NO PARKING IS ALLOWED AT WORDSWORTH OR PLAY and LEARN**
- We will be running shuttle buses from New Life Church (2015 S. Limekiln Pike, Dresher) to Or Hadash. We will have parking volunteers to assist in loading at New Life Church.
- If taking the bus will be physically difficult for you, there will be parking available for you at Or Hadash.

**Rosh Hashanah - second day (Tuesday, September 11):**

- **NO PARKING IS ALLOWED AT WORDSWORTH OR PLAY and LEARN.**
- All parking is in the Or Hadash lot.
- Overflow parking will be in the neighborhood streets. Parking volunteers will help direct you should overflow parking be required.

**Kol Nidre evening service (Tuesday, September 18):**

In addition to the parking lot at Or Hadash, we are also permitted to use the parking lots at both Wordsworth Academy and Play N Learn (after 6:00) for overflow parking. The wooded path from Wordsworth to Or Hadash will be lit at sundown to facilitate using the path after services to return to your vehicle.

**Yom Kippur (Wednesday, September 20):**

In addition to the parking lot at Or Hadash, we are permitted to use the parking lot at Wordsworth Academy for overflow parking. **NO PARKING IS ALLOWED AT PLAY and LEARN**
