

Tashlich

On Rosh Hashanah, Jews typically visit a naturally flowing body of water, into which we throw breadcrumbs that are symbolic of our sins - that is the Tashlich ritual. At Or Hadash, we gather as a community at the lake in nearby Cisco Park for this ceremonial “casting away” of our sins.

You are invited to travel with us after the second day of Rosh Hashanah kiddush at 1:00 pm from Or Hadash, or join us directly at Cisco Park at 1:15 pm. Please bring old bread to be thrown into the lake.



We also encourage you to bring blankets or chairs and picnic lunches to extend the celebration with the community.



Directions to Cisco Park for Tashlich : 3.7 miles, 10 minutes
Cisco Park, 199 Montgomery Avenue, Erdenheim, PA
~ Exit from Or Hadash turning right onto Camp Hill Road.
Cross Pennsylvania Avenue and continue on Camp Hill Road for 0.4 miles.
~ After going under the railroad bridge, turn left onto Walnut Ave for 0.5 miles.
~ Turn right onto Oreland Mill Road. Follow Oreland Mill Road for 0.9 miles to it's end where it meets Church Road. You should see Enfield Elementary School across the street at the corner of Church and Paper Mill Roads.
~ Join Church Road by making a slight left.
~ Turn right at the stoplight onto Paper Mill Road and follow Paper Mill Road for 1.6 miles to Montgomery Avenue.
~ Turn right onto Montgomery Avenue and the Cisco Park parking lot will be on the left in about 300 feet.
