


with sorrow in our hearts

Like all of you, I am deeply saddened by the senseless deaths of Israeli teens Naftali Fraenkel, Gilad Shaar, and Eyal Yifrah, whose bodies were found earlier this afternoon following their abduction nearly three weeks ago.
