- Share your large back yard on Saturday evening, August 28** for the Selichot program (capacity to hook up a video projector/screen helpful, and location reasonably close to OH needed)

### SERVICE HONORS

- \* **Candle Lighting** light and bless the holiday candles from the comfort of your home, LIVE on Zoom!
- Lead Erev Rosh Hashanah Kiddush** chant the festival kiddush at our digital RH Seder
- Blow the Shofar** live in the sanctuary on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of Rosh Hashanah.
- Blow the Shofar** from home on the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of Rosh Hashanah.  
(even if you do not have prior experience, everyone is welcome to bring a shofar to the end of Yom Kippur service)
- Carrying the Torah through the congregation**
- \* **English Reading** for one person
- \* **English Reading** for two people (i.e.: alternating sections)
- \* **Open/ Close the Ark**
- \* **Holiday Greeting** pre-record and submit a 5-10 second "holiday greeting" from you or your family to be played during one of the times the ark is opened or closed on the second day of Rosh Hashanah or Kol Nidrei.
- Lifting or dressing the Torah** (prior experience required, circle one)
