It will be the service and program portion of the Shabbat Havurah evening already scheduled for that night. - 2. Robert Goldberg-Alberts will discuss the Biblical personality Ruth, as told in the Book of Ruth.
- 3. Rabbi Alanna will discuss Rashi, the famous Medieval Bible Commentator.

Our evening will conclude with the chanting of the Ten Commandments, traditional Torah reading for the holiday of Shavuot, outdoors if weather permits.
