We are delighted to offer childcare again this year!

Parents will find it easier to support their children's participation in whatever youth-centric services and activities are appropriate for them, without having to bring siblings to programming that isn't geared to them. • If you do NOT register in advance, you are welcome to take your child upstairs to ask the childcare provider if they can comfortably take responsibility for your child. They will do so if possible, but we reserve the right to decline if the number of people who wish to drop-off their children proves unwieldy.

### Childcare is being held in the classrooms on the second floor.

• We regret that the second floor is only accessible by stairs and we regret that there is no wheelchair/stroller accessible location in which we can hold childcare. Childcare will be based in classrooms 207 and 205, although our childcare provider may take the children in their care to the High Holiday children's activity stations in 203.
